- 1 Village Centre
A variety of shops, services, dining opportunities and accommodations are clustered along Grenville St. and adjacent side streets.
- 2 Canal Lock
A historic tidal lock canal, operating since 1869, continues to link Bras d'Or Lake with the Atlantic Ocean.
- 3 Canal Bridge
When the bridge swings, watch for boats coming through!
- 4 Lions Marina
Our community marina welcomes transient yachts: docks, anchorage, showers, fuel, laundry & more.
- 5 Lions Hall & Recreation Area
Site of community events from bingo and cards to dances, auctions and concerts; baseball, soccer, oval running track and children's playground.
- 6 East Richmond Education Centre (EREC)
Primary and middle school for St. Peter's and area.
- 7 Richmond Villa
Our seniors and special care facility.
- 8 Nicolas Denys Museum
Historical museum: early settlement, culture, the canal.
- 9 MacAskill House Museum
Birthplace of Wallace MacAskill, native son and internationally acclaimed photographer.
- 10 Post Office (Community Kiosk)
Find out where the action is: current events and public notice board.
- 11 Jerome Point Lighthouse
Since 1875, this beacon has guided vessels arriving from around the globe into our canal.
- 12 Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP)
St. Peter's Detachment
- 13 Ocean View Wildlife Museum
Wildlife preservation museum featuring mounted species from the local area and European countries.
- ? Visitor Information Centre
Travel counsellors, literature and displays.
